We are a nonprofit corporation providing fire, rescue, fire police, and emergency ambulance services. These services, and many more, are provided by a combination of career staff and dedicated volunteers. **We respond to over 3,600 ambulance, 600 fire and rescue, and 500 fire police calls per year.** 2020 and 2021 have been anything but normal as everyone adapts to changes associated with the COVID-19 virus. Our Pandemic Committee continues to implement strategies to help ensure our career staff and volunteers can safely respond to the needs of our community.

Even though the pandemic negatively impacted our 2021 flower sales, hall rentals and Sunday breakfasts, we were excited to be able to bring the community together for our 72nd annual Goshen Country Fair. We want to thank everyone for attending the fair; it was a pleasure to see everyone having a great time.

Becoming a subscriber not only supports the Goshen Fire Company, but it could also save you money if you need emergency ambulance services. As a subscriber, you will not be responsible for any fees charged by Goshen Fire Company for 911 emergency ambulance services that are not covered by your insurance. Many insurance plans do not cover the full cost of an ambulance transport. This cost starts at \$1,100.

SUBSCRIPTION TYPES

We offer five levels of Subscriptions:

FAMILY PLUS • \$125

 Covers all adults and children that reside in a household

FAMILY • \$100

 Covers up to 2 adults and all children under 18 in the household

INDIVIDUAL • \$60

Covers 1 adult

SENIOR FAMILY • \$85

 Covers 2 adults in a household (at least 1 adult must be 65+)

SENIOR INDIVIDUAL • \$50

Covers 1 adult (65+)
